Dupath Spring Solar Farm Public Consultation

EDF power solutions is planning to develop a 49.9 MW solar farm – Dupath Spring Solar Farm – located in east Cornwall, northwest of the village of St Mellion. The proposed solar project is 80 hectares, within an approximately 126-hectare site, and has very good levels of solar irradiation. It is proposed that the grid connection to Landulph substation, circa 6.5km away, will run underground and will not be visible.

- Capacity of up to 49.9 MW
- Plans for additional planting to enhance biodiversity on site
- The project will deliver local benefits, including a community fund

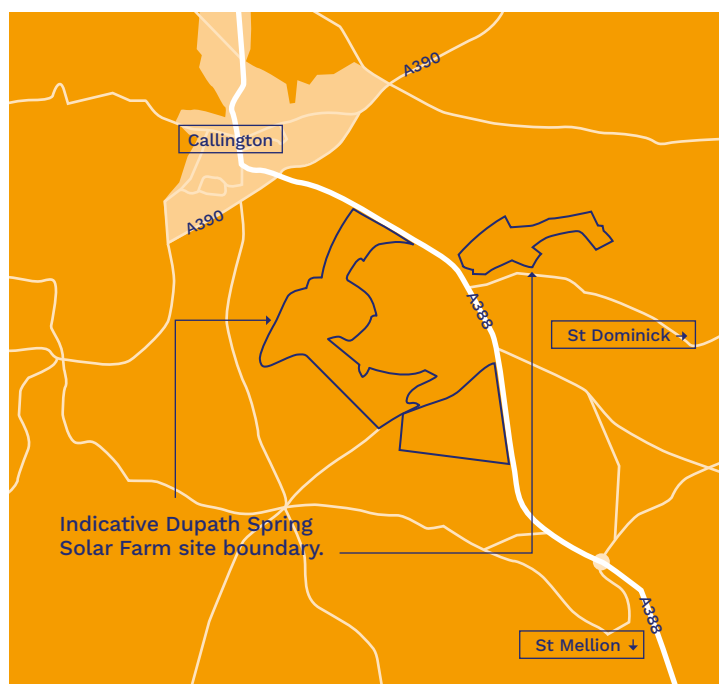
